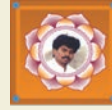

The Kaleshwar Charitable Trust (KCT) is a non profit Charity founded in December 2008.

The objects for Kaleshwar Charitable Trust are:

- The promotion of spiritual welfare.
- The relief of those in need by reason of age, ill health or financial hardship.
- Providing teachings, training and research in the topics of Ancient Indian Spiritual Knowledge.
- Organising and conducting lectures, conferences and courses.

The KCT is currently supporting various charitable projects in India.

This includes the *Navya Shree Free Eye Hospital*, the *Sri Kaleshwar Educational Trust* as well as the newly established *Shirdi Sai Global Trust Medical Clinic*.



Through generous donations from England and Germany the *Shirdi Sai Global Trust Medical Clinic* could be inaugurated on January 8th, 2016 in Penukonda. Its main purpose is to provide medical health care for poor and needy people. It ensures a proper health checkup free of cost, as well as free medications for all the patients, who need medicines.



There are currently two Indian doctors and two nurses working full time at the *Medical Clinic*. On a daily basis they examine and consult many patients from the destitute villages. The staff's monthly salary is financed by donations. The Kaleshwar Charitable Trust is dedicated to support this long-term project and is keen to contribute to the development of the building and to the medical support and care.
